Providing proper training, tools and equipment give JEG the best opportunity to perform at its highest level on the job site, thus reaching our goal of employees returning home safely while ensuring a satisfied customer and a profitable job.

An Injury Free Workplace occurs through proper site and task plans, **individual** safety awareness, and safe work habits. JEG will maintain its status as an industry leader in safety management through benchmarking, statistical analysis and recognition programs that will continue to be a part of JEG's effort toward an Injury Free Workplace.
